WINDOWS 7 PC SUPPORT ENDS IN JANUARY 2020 DO YOU NEED TO UPGRADE YOUR PC?

After 14th January 2020 Microsoft will no longer provide any Security Updates for their Windows 7 platform. This means that anyone who still operates a Windows 7 PC, that accesses the internet after that date, will no longer be secure from future attacks on their windows operating system.
